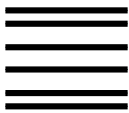

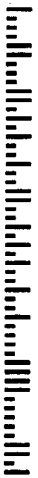
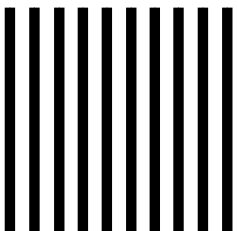

What is the Academic Resource Program?

The Academic Resource Program (ARP) at the C.W. Post Campus of Long Island University is a comprehensive support program designed to teach students with learning disabilities and/or AD/HD skills and strategies that will help them achieve their academic potential in a university setting. The Program is part of the Learning Support Center, which offers “serious programs for serious students.”

For over 20 years, the Academic Resource Program has helped hundreds of college students with a variety of learning disabilities and/or AD/HD succeed academically. The ARP will provide you with the opportunity, structure, and support necessary to achieve your academic goals.

At the ARP we believe that you are an individual and, as such, bring to the learning environment a variety of experiences. These experiences affect your classroom performance. Our staff of caring and experienced professionals will help you develop the academic, social, problem-solving, and strategic skills to achieve your goals.

During your first year in the Academic Resource Program, you will take a course load of 12 credits and participate in all of the ARP's services including counseling and extensive tutoring. Students enrolled in the ARP attend regular classes and are expected to meet all academic requirements. While course content is not altered or compromised for our students, participation in ARP will help you succeed in the classroom.

The fee for our Program is \$1,600 per semester, which is in addition to the cost for tuition, room and board, and books. The fee covers:

- One-to-one tutoring with trained learning assistants
- Academic and life skills workshops
- Course and scheduling guidance
- Access to our state-of-the-art computer lab equipped with Internet service, assistive technology, and other programs

Admission Criteria

You must apply for admission to the University prior to applying to our Program. The phone number for the Office of Admissions is (516) 299-2900. Interested students should call that office to request an application and admissions information. Be sure to check off the box marked Academic Resource Program when you complete the application. When you are accepted into the University, your information will be sent to us and we will send you our application.

Please note that admission to the University is separate and distinct from your acceptance into the Academic Resource Program.

The enrollment quota for the Program fills up quickly, so we encourage you to begin the process of applying to C.W. Post as soon as possible.
